



Prof. Dr. Geerten M.M. Michielse (1960) is the director of the Center for Taxation and Public Governance, an independent knowledge center for tax governance, which contributes to the strengthening of governments in the fields of tax policy, tax administration, tax management and legal drafting. The Center provides research on taxation and development issues as well as training to tax officials. Michielse is as tax professor linked to various European universities, amongst which the universities of Nijmegen (NLD), Paris (FRA), and Vienna (AUT). Furthermore, he

has been invited for guest lectures at universities in the United States, Japan, and Brazil. In addition, he has been providing technical assistance in tax policy and legal drafting to a number of countries in Central and Eastern Europe, Africa, and Asia on behalf of the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank. Recently he worked on major tax reforms in the Middle East. His publications on international and comparative tax issues have appeared in renown tax magazines around the world. Occasionally, Michielse has been asked to testify before parliamentary commissions (both the Dutch and European Parliament).
