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Activity 3. Roadmap on European and international funds for local authorities in Armenia¹

Within the roadmap we will provide details on funded opportunities (at European and international level) for Armenian local authorities. There are several types of cooperation: regional, bilateral and thematic. The bilateral dimension supports closer bilateral relations between the European Union and each Eastern partner country, in our case, Armenia. The regional and thematic dimensions provide a forum for dialogue and exchange between partners. This is done via thematic platforms and strengthens activities in support of the EU bilateral relationship with individual partners.

Recently, the European Commission introduced the Team Europe Partnerships Portal (TEPP) (available at https://www.acc.team-europe-partners.eu/home). This is a new platform that supports member states and partner countries in finding innovative and effective tools to build sustainable societies and reach development goals. At the moment, the platform is working in test mode and some partner countries will be added shorter (including Armenia). Once Armenia will be added to the portal, we highly recommend to register your organisations and search for opportunities.
